

I Campi, I Campi Lunghi 2013 Amarone della Valpolicella

Score 16.5/20

Classic blend of Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella. Mid ruby. A little prickle of the alcohol on the nose, but otherwise an elegant amalgamate of oak bark, pepper and dried cherry while not trying to push the dried, passito notes too much, as is so often the case. This has freshness, elegance and fine tannins on the palate, but the whole is a little too sweet for me. Drinking well now, but to be a contender for the long haul, it needs less sweetness, but this certainly is part of a new generation of Amarones and miles away from the fat, extracted, sweet concoctions that clog the international market.
